



Harukumo-Juku – House Rules

The Juku is a place of meeting, learning and exchange. Here different individuals come together to pursue their common passion. In order to make this a positive experience for everyone, a few basic rules are set out below.

Violations of these rules will be sanctioned with a house ban. The decision will be made by the responsible persons of the Juku.

Consensus

- ❖ Make sure that you only do to each other what you want to do to each other. Only a yes is a yes, a no is always a no. When in doubt, a maybe is also a no.
- ❖ Respect the boundaries of others, both those of your play and bondage partners and the boundaries of the rest of us (for example, when you tie up in a small space or are very intimate with each other).
- ❖ If something has happened to you that you do not feel comfortable with, or you are unsure about something, please come directly to us so that we can look at it together.

Security

- ❖ Use only safe material and check your ropes, carabiners, rings, etc. regularly.
- ❖ We check the beams and ropes regularly, but we still ask you to actively check the suspension points before you use them.
- ❖ Be sober when tying up, whether active or passive. There is a 0-promille limit, and we enforce this without tolerance.
- ❖ Only tie patterns that you have mastered.
- ❖ Always have a safety knife or scissors at hand.
- ❖ If you need help or are unsure about anything, contact us, we will be happy to support you (as a "spotter" or otherwise).

❖ Food and Drinks / Hygiene

- ❖ Please consume food and drinks only in the lounge
- ❖ Please make sure that no drinks or other food gets on the tatami
- ❖ Water may be taken to the bondage sites in PET bottles or other containers that do not splinter, break or otherwise compromise the safety of yourself or others
- ❖ Please observe basic hygiene measures. Make sure that no bodily fluids get on the tatami. We are happy to provide towels if you want to put something underneath on warm days or if you like to tie up with less clothes.
